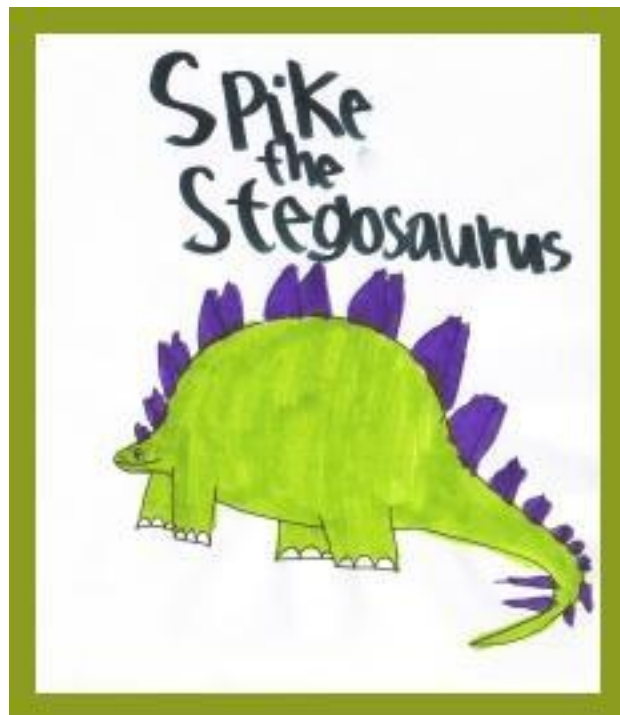

Spinosaurus was huge! He probably used his large sail (as other dinos did) to catch the sunlight and keep his body warm when the sun went down.

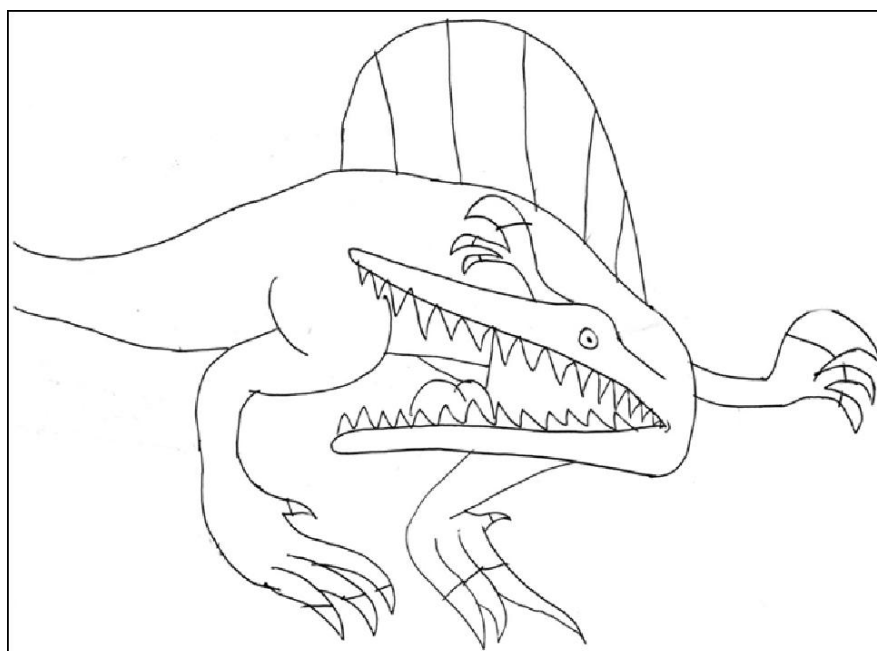
Stegosaurus Joke
